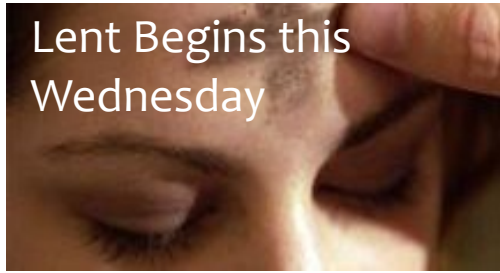

Named in honor of Bill Monroe, "The Father of Bluegrass Music," **Monroe Crossing**, now celebrating their 12th year together, dazzles audiences with an electrifying blend of classic bluegrass, bluegrass gospel, and heartfelt originals. Their airtight harmonies, razor sharp arrangements, and on-stage rapport make them audience favorites across the United States and Canada.

Based in Minnesota, the group plays an average of 125 shows a year at major venues and festivals, frequently for non-bluegrass audiences — and people often comment that they'd never really liked bluegrass music until they attended a Monroe Crossing concert!
