

Faith Statement Guide

At the conclusion of your Confirmation year, you have the opportunity to share your faith story. Your life has been influenced by parents, family, friends, other adults, Sunday School classes, etc. This is a time for you to reflect on these life experiences and how they have affected your faith.

Your Faith Statement should focus on your faith journey. Following are some important points that should be included - remember it doesn't need to be a writing. It can be a drawing, a sculpture, something you build, etc. If you do not **write** your Faith Statement, please include a description with your artwork.

- Your experiences through the church with your family
- Those who have been influential and encouraging during your faith journey
- What your baptism means to you
- Who Jesus is in your life
- What Jesus' death and resurrection means for you
- What Jesus' death and resurrection means for creation
- How being a Christian makes a difference in how you live
- The importance of Holy Communion in your everyday life
- How important prayer is to you
- How you see yourself serving Christ in your life

There is so much more you could share. As an individual, think about what is important to you to include. Remember your faith statement will not be judged, but it will be discussed. Be honest and truthful. Include struggles you still have.
